Performing Musician Expectations

1. Qualifications

Performing musicians may participate in the Southwest Washington Wind Symphony (SWWS) at the invitation of the board of directors. They shall be invited based upon their musical competence, professionalism, commitment to the goals of the organization, and instrumental vacancies considering the instrumental balance desired by the conductor.

Performing musicians may continue with the SWWS at the discretion of the board of directors by maintaining musical competence, agreeing to and demonstrating the "conditions of participation".

2. Conditions of Participation

Performing musicians are expected to:

- a. Attend all rehearsals and concerts, unless previously arranged with the board of directors.
- b. Have music practiced and ready for each rehearsal.
- c. Arrive at each rehearsal and concert in enough time to prepare their instrument and accomplish their warm up routine so the rehearsal may begin on time.
- d. Be responsible for any music received and return it at the conclusion of a concert series. The performing musician is financially responsible for any of his/her lost music.
- e. Assist with the setup and teardown of any rehearsal or concert space.
- f. Behave with courtesy and respect to all participants and to contribute to the SWWS culture of musical excellence, professionalism, and community. As an expression of this respect and courtesy please remember to:

 - 2) refrain from smoking at rehearsals and concerts.
 - 3) refrain from wearing cologne, aftershave, or perfumes as others may be sensitive or allergic.
